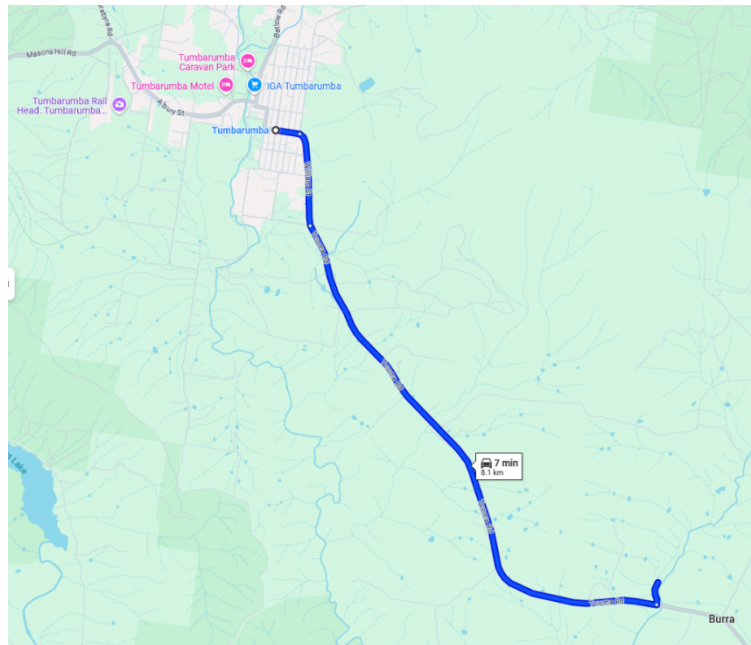

Mandatory Equipment

Spot checks can occur anywhere on course, runners found without mandatory equipment will face a 30 minute time penalty.

Mandatory Equipment Checklist

- Mobile phone, charged, with course map saved to phone (See course description for instructions)
- Whistle
- Broad compressive bandage (snake bandage with compression indicator)
- Water containers (Minimum 1L Total Capacity)

The following items may be required if inclement weather is forecast. To be advised by Thursday October 9th.

- Longsleeve thermal top
- Gloves & beanie/buff
- Breathable, waterproof jacket with taped seams

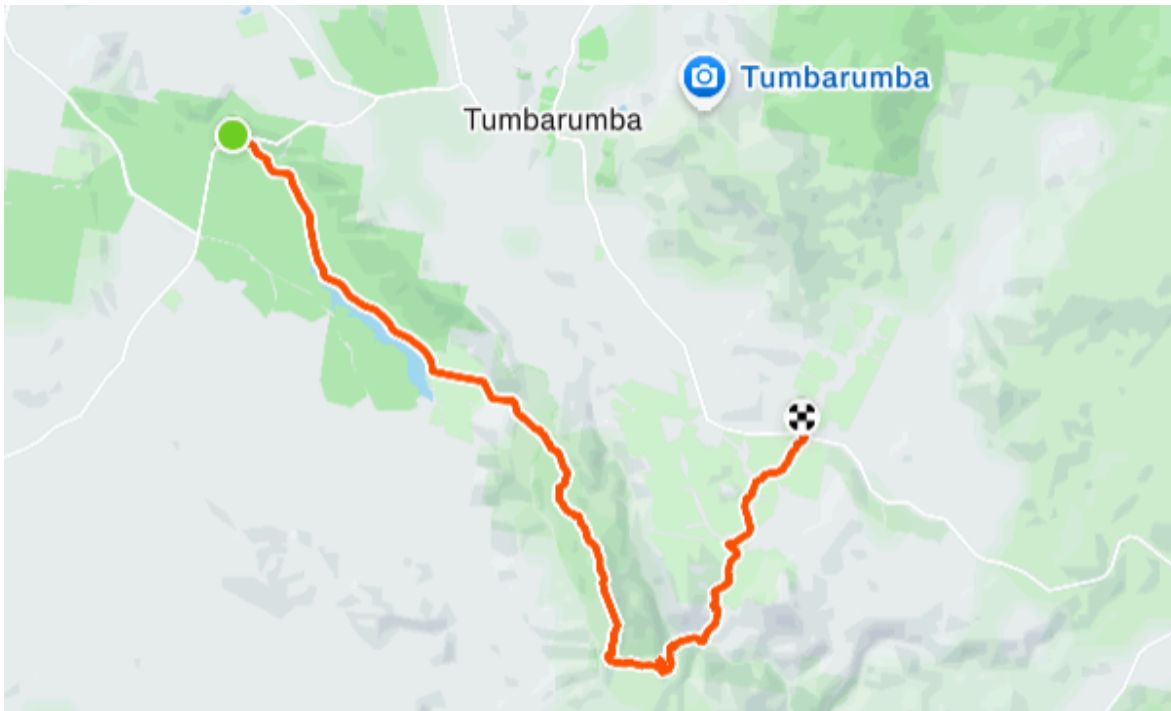
Course Information

Course is subject to change up until the race starts due to trail and road conditions.

22km Course Description

Please note, the bus from Henry Angel to the start line is mandatory and included in your race entry fee. The bus departs at 8:15 from the entry to Henry Angel campsite, please aim to be there by 8am.

The race begins at Mannus Campsite with 3km of undulating dirt road, before crossing a stile to run through farmland and on boardwalk along Mannus Lake to the creatively named Mannus Lake Aid Station. From here, follow the dirt road and pay close attention, the Hume and Hovell track diverts sharply left from the road after a cattle grid. A 4km climb takes you to the Mt Garland Aid Station, despite the name, you aren't done climbing, after the aid station you will descend for 2km, before another 2km takes you over Mt Garland and the race's high point. Enjoy a scenic view of the ranges as you descend to the Tumbarumba Creek crossing. A gradual climb back to Henry Angel Aid station awaits you, make sure you keep an eye out for course markers, there are multiple stiles and a sharp left on this section where many an inattentive runner has followed the goat track up the hill instead. One last stile, cross under Tooma Road, and head up the finishers chute to complete your 22km adventure!
